## 1. Purpose and Requirements

This procedure provides a listing of building materials that potential contain asbestos. The list represents typical campus building material and is provided as a quick reference tool. For a complete list see New York State Code Rule 56.

## 2. Scope

Applies to Ithaca campus and remote facilities.

## 3. Responsibilities

### 3.1 EHS

Maintain the potential asbestos containing material building product list and update the Standard Operating Procedure accordingly.

## 4. Presumed Asbestos Containing Material (PACM)

### 4.1 Surfacing Treatments:

- 4.1.1 Fireproofing;
- 4.1.2 Acoustical Plaster;
- 4.1.3 Finish Plasters; and
- 4.1.4 Skim Coats of Joint Compound.

### 4.2 (ii) Thermal System Insulation:

- 4.2.1 Equipment Insulation;
- 4.2.2 Boiler, Breeching, Boiler Rope, Duct, or Tank Insulation, Cement or Mortar Used for Boilers and Refractory Brick;
- 4.2.3 Piping and Fitting Insulations including but not limited to, Wrapped Paper, Aircell, Millboard, Rope, Cork, Preformed Plaster, Job Molded Plaster and coverings over fibrous glass insulation.
